Introduction

- 3 Thank you for taking part in the public consultation of the GRI Labor Standards for Labor Rights in
- 4 Business Relationships, Freedom of Association and Collective Bargaining, Child Labor, and Forced
- 5 Labor. These four draft Standards are part of 'Phase 3 Workers' rights and protection', focusing on
- 6 rights and protections at work.
- 7 The GRI Topic Standard Project for Labor consists of three thematic phases: Employment practices
- 8 and conditions, Working life and career development, and Workers' rights and protection.
- 9 These four Topic Standards are published for public comment by the Global Sustainability Standards
- 10 Board (GSSB), the independent standard-setting body of GRI, in line with the GSSB Due Process
- 11 <u>Protocol</u>. Any interested party can submit comments on the exposure drafts using this online survey.
- Note: The exposure drafts are published for public consultation only, and their content may change
- 13 before the final versions of the Standards are released for use.
